

AURA AERIAL COMPETITION

RULES

Competition Area: Stainless steel structure (pyramid) with a soft landing mat beneath the apparatus.

Technical specifications of the structure: height 6.3 mt, ground footprint triangle 5.8 mt side

The competition is open for everyone

All participants who accept the competition rules are eligible to compete. All competitors participate at their own risk! Parents and coaches are responsible for ensuring that the competitors are in suitable health to participate. Coaches are responsible for assembling the choreography elements and selecting their level of difficulty.

The organizers and the venue provider accept no responsibility for any injuries occurring during the performance or the preceding warm-up or practice.

Coaches and competitors are responsible for the accuracy and authenticity of the information provided in the application.

Competitors must follow the event schedule and be present beside the stage at least three performances before their own.

Competitors must appear on stage within 5 seconds of being announced.

By submitting the application form, the competition rules are considered accepted.

The schedule is informative only; all participants must be ready to perform at least one hour before their planned time.

Competitors must wear their performance attire during the awards ceremony.

Swinging the apparatus is not allowed!

The Organizer reserves the right to record the performances and routines during the event. All photos and videos remain the property of the Organizer, who may use them for promotional purposes or delete them if they are deemed inappropriate based on the participation rules.

By registering, participants waive any rights to control or seek compensation for the use of photos or videos taken of them.

The Organizer reserves the right to modify the rules or the event conditions (e.g., postponement, cancellation, etc.).

Organizer's Responsibilities:

Provide medical supervision during the event.

Ensure appropriate conditions for participants (changing rooms, warm-up area).

The Organizer is not responsible for participants' personal belongings.

The Organizer and its representatives of AURA AERIAL COMPETITION are not liable for any injury or damage resulting from participation in the event.

For any matters not regulated by this document, the Organizer has the right to make unilateral decisions.

The Organizer reserves the right to modify the participation rules, which will be published on their social media platforms where possible.

For any questions about props or equipment, the organizers will provide clarification.

ORIGINAL PROP

Junior 2013-2009 year of birth

Adults 2008+ year of birth

Props that can be used in this category: aerial loops, straps, aerial net, rope, trapeze. Participants must bring their own prop for this category. Lift is not allowed.

DUO (ALL PROPS)

In this category all props may be used (silks, hoop, straps, aerial loops) and there is no age or level divisions in this category. Lift is not allowed.

The organizers reserve right to merge or separate categories depending on the amount of competitors, which will be published on their social media platforms by June 1st.

The jury reserves right to move a competitor from a beginner category to advanced in case it is agreed among the judges that the level of the athlete fits an advanced category.

Beginner:

They have never been in a competition or only once and never got 1st 2nd or 3rd in a competition where there were more the 5 competitors.

Tricks that **ARE NOT ALLOWED** in the beginner categories.

SILKS: balance split, open grip drops, single foot drop, reverse meathook, dynamic release/catch moves

HOOP: heels hanging (two feet hanging is allowed), neck hanging, reverse meathook (back flag), dynamic catch/release moves, dismounts from hoop (only dismount from knees on the lower bar is allowed)

Advanced (Pro):

More experienced competitors. Already competed in multiple championships. In previous competitions got 1st, 2nd or 3rd place out of at least 6 competitors. Practising aerial gymnastics coaches and aerial performers.

Floorwork is allowed in all categories. Maximum duration of the floor work choreography is 15 seconds and it must be put only at the beginning of the perforce. The floorwork is optional, not mandatory.

PROPS

HOOP

SILK

The organizers will provide red silks (nylon, medium stretch) 6 mt (12 mt full length) and hoops 85, 90,95,102 cm.

Participants are allowed to use their own prop.

Participation Requirements

Only athletes who have submitted a valid individual entry within May 15th, 2026 are eligible for their category.

MUSIC

Beginner: 2:15 - 3:00

Advanced (Pro): 3:00 - 4:00

The music must be in MP3 format (should be uploaded on the website during the registration)

Deadline: 15 May 2026

AWARDS

In each category the winner will receive a trophy and the 2nd and 3rd place will receive a medal.

Each performance (regardless of placement) receives a certificate.

Special Awards

As decided by the Jury, the following special awards will be presented:

Special awards will be presented during the final award ceremony. In case of disputes, the Jury will make the final decision. All jury decisions are final and cannot be appealed. Competitors must not contact Jury members during the competition.

During the award ceremonies, all competitors are required to appear in their performance costume.

Application Requirements for Competitors

Application deadline and payment of registration fees: May 15, 2026.

A payment confirmation must be sent via email; the registration is only valid once the confirmation is received.

The signed liability waiver must be uploaded through the registration link.

By submitting the application form, the participant acknowledges and accepts the entire set of rules and regulations of the competition.
